

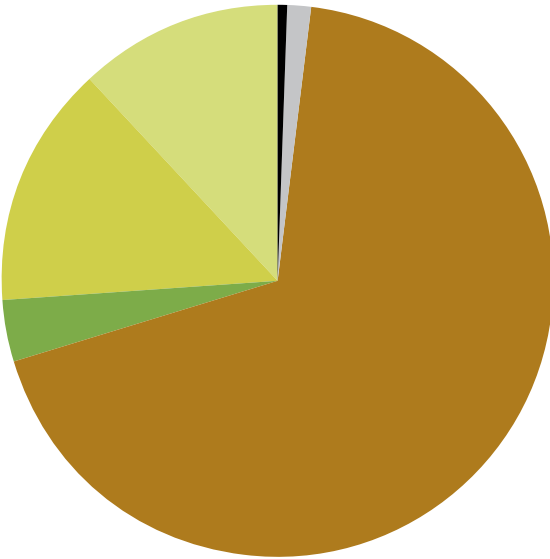

PACKAGING

When packaging products, as little as possible plastic packaging materials are used. More than 95% of the product components come from suppliers located within a radius of 200 kilometers around our production facility.
